



For those seeking a longer, more challenging ride, this circuit takes in some of the best cycling routes in the two local government areas of Lake Macquarie and Newcastle, through peaceful bushland and around the foreshore of our magnificent lake.

47kms, easy to moderate hills, mainly off-road but with some difficult on-road sections, for experienced riders.



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The circuit route includes Fernleigh Track with the historic railway tunnel under the Pacific Highway; the Lake Foreshore Path with the enormous disability-friendly playground at Speers Point Park and the Red Bluff boardwalk over the lake at Eleebana; the Tramway Track with native bush; and link back via Jesmond Park to the Adamstown start of Fernleigh Track.

From Bikefest, connect to the Two City Circuit at Adamstown via the NSW Coastal Cycleway Route 1 through Hamilton, or at Wallsend via Route 6 to the University.


To link these cycle paths, the ride goes on busy roads including the Bareki Road bends at Eleebana and Lake Road between Boolaroo and Glendale. Because of traffic conditions on-road, it is best to follow the circuit in a clockwise direction. Riders should take care on paths shared with pedestrians and children.
