



Follow shared path to Stockton Bridge and bird roost.

A ferry to Stockton then a self-guided scenic ride along coast, wetlands and harbour foreshore. This ride is part of the NSW Coastal Cycleway Route. Parking Station at Lee Wharf.

12km each way, flat, can stay off-road all the way, requires minimal fitness

From Honeysuckle Foreshore, take the ferry to Stockton. Ride along the Hunter River foreshore to the Sandspit at Stockton Bridge where you can view the internationally significant shorebird roost. Do not access the roost. This ride is part of the NSW Coastal Cycleway Route.

For a complete off-road experience, return along the same path, past the ferry and around to the northern breakwater where you can view the wreck of the Adolphe. Go on to eat at Lexies by the Beach cafe or Stockton Bowling Club, or picnic in the foreshore park.

For an alternative return route to the ferry wharf via backstreets behind the coastline.

Ferries generally run at half hourly intervals on weekdays and Saturdays from 5:45am to 12midnight, and on Sundays from 8:45am to 10pm. Check ferry times at www.newcastlebuses.info/routes.
