



Tramway Track is a delightful ride along an off-road shared path through natural bushland between Glendale TAFE and Wallsend shops. It follows the former steam tram route with gentle slopes so you will need a basic level of fitness. 4.2km each way, easy to moderate, requires a basic level of fitness.

Connect to the Tramway Track from Honeysuckle via the 10.7km sign-posted Route 6 to the University. Ride through the University then go along Nelson Street to Wallsend. The route takes off-road shared paths and quiet backstreets that are suitable for cyclists with some experience.

Connect to the Tramway Track from Lake Macquarie by following the lake foreshore path through Speers Point Park. From the park, ride along Lake Road, mainly in a wide verge, to Glendale TAFE in Frederick Street (5.3km). There is often heavy traffic on Lake Road so this ride is not recommended for inexperienced riders or children. Topography gentle.
